PROCLAMATION NUMBER 155 JBE 2017

RESCIND PROCLAMATION NUMBER 99 JBE 2017

SPECIAL ELECTION – CHIEF OF POLICE, TOWN OF EROS, PARISH OF JACKSON

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 99 JBE 2017, issued on August 24, 2017, ordered a special primary and a special general election to be held throughout the jurisdiction of the Town of Eros, Parish of Jackson, for the purpose of electing a chief of police to fill the vacancy in the office, with qualifying to occur during the period commencing Wednesday, July 18, 2018, and ending at 4:30 p.m. Friday, July 20, 2018, a primary election to occur on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, and the general election shall be held Saturday, December 8, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State has confirmed that a special primary and a special general election are scheduled to be held throughout the jurisdiction of the Town of Eros, Parish of Jackson, for the purpose of electing a chief of police to fill the vacancy in the office, with qualifying to occur during the period commencing Wednesday, July 18, 2018, and ending at 4:30 p.m. Friday, July 20, 2018, a primary election to occur on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, and the general election shall be held Saturday, December 8, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State has further confirmed that the governing authority of the Town of Eros timely submitted an ordinance to be voted on in the November 18, 2017 election to change the position of chief of police, Town of Eros, Parish of Jackson, from an elected position to an appointed position, in accordance with La. R.S. 33:381.2 and that the people voted in favor of changing the position of chief of police, Town of Eros, Parish of Jackson, from an elected position to an appointed position in the November 18, 2017 election; and


WHEREAS, it is not necessary to order a special election for the purpose of filling the vacancy of chief of police, Town of Eros, Parish of Jackson as that position is now an appointed position.

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOHN BEL EDWARDS, Governor of the State of Louisiana, by virtue of the authority vested by the Constitution and the laws of the State of Louisiana, do hereby order and direct as follows:

SECTION 1: Proclamation No. 99 JBE 2017 is rescinded.
